Undergraduate 2022 key dates

Students should ensure they have submitted and paid for their undergraduate application by 1 December to be guaranteed equal consideration. Applications submitted and/or paid for after this date will not be guaranteed equal consideration with the exclusion of courses with final closing dates.

The first offer round in which most current Year 12 applicants are expected to be able to participate on the basis of their ATARs will be on 21 December. The change of preference deadline for this offer round is 15 December. The following offer round will be on 14 January with a change of preference deadline of 10 January.

Arrangements for interstate Year 12 applicants

The disruption caused by COVID-19 to Year 12 students in 2021 has led to a delay in results release for students in some states and territories. SATAC and our institutions are aware of this, and our universities plan the timing and volume of offers based on the availability of results.

Offers to courses at SATAC's participating universities can and will be made to students whose results have been delayed as a result of these disruptions. You should, however, remind your students that [relevant key dates to do with undergraduate applications](#) are still applicable.

Changes to 2022 undergraduate offer round dates

There has been a slight change to the [undergraduate offer rounds](#) scheduled for 2022. There will now be an offer round on 24 January, and the 27 January offer round will no longer go ahead.

The 24 January offer round will be the first round in which NSW and ACT HSC students can be considered on the basis of their ATARs.

All other offer rounds will go ahead as scheduled.

TAFE SA 2022 key dates

The first offer round for TAFE SA semester 1 2022 is on Friday 3 December 2021.

Students should complete course admission and selection criteria requirements by 23 November for consideration in the offer round.

Students completing the Core Skills Profile for Adults (CSPA) should do so by 30 November.

The next offer round will then be 7 January 2022.
