



Tertiary Entrance Statement – SATAC Changes

Up until 2024 SATAC sent the Tertiary Entrance Statement (TES) by post alongside the SACE Record of Achievement. From 2025, this document will only be available digitally via your SACE Students Online account.

You will be able to download and print this document as you require.

What is the Tertiary Entrance Statement?

The Tertiary Entrance Statement is a document which shows information relevant to tertiary entrance, such as the university aggregate and ATAR. SATAC issues the TES for South Australian students on behalf of Flinders University, Adelaide University, and TAFE SA. The TES for Northern Territory students is issued on behalf of Charles Darwin University.

What happens if my results change?

If your results change, your TES will be updated to reflect any changes that may have happened, and you will be able to reprint any updated TES.

Can I request a printed copy of my Tertiary Entrance Statement?

You can print an official copy of your Tertiary Entrance Statement directly from your SACE student online.

Do I need to provide a copy of my Tertiary Entrance Statement to SATAC for an application?

Students applying for tertiary study in Australia through a tertiary admissions centre, such as SATAC, will not need to provide documentation of their senior secondary results as they can be accessed electronically based on the SACE registration number entered in your application.

Students applying directly to a tertiary institution in Australia can provide digital copies of their results as part of the application process.

Students applying for tertiary study overseas can also download their results from SACE Students Online and provide them digitally or in hard copy.
