TAFE SA early offer round

SATAC will email an early offer round for some TAFE SA courses starting in semester 1 2019 on Friday 30 November 2018. The early offer round will consider first preferences only and not all TAFE SA courses will make offers in this round.

TAFE SA English Language requirements for nursing courses

TAFE SA Nursing courses now have an additional Course Admission Requirement where applicants must demonstrate 'Satisfactory evidence of meeting the Nursing and Midwifery Board of Australia's (NMBA) English language skills registration standards'.
