Students should submit their undergraduate applications by Thursday, 30 September 2021. Application fees will increase after this date.

The following courses at the University of Adelaide are also closing on 30 September:

- Medical Studies/Medicine (including Bonded Medical Program)
- Dental Surgery
- Oral Health
- Veterinary Bioscience

Don't forget some other courses with final closing dates coming up later this year:

- Creative Arts (Drama) at Flinders University on 22 November
- Clinical Sciences/Doctor of Medicine at Flinders University on 1 December
- Occupational Therapy, Physiotherapy and Speech Pathology at the University of Adelaide on 1 December

Late applications are not accepted for courses with final closing dates.

The following courses at Charles Darwin University are also closing on 1 December. They may not accept late applications (check if applying after this date):

- Clinical Sciences
- Midwifery
- Paramedicine

Conditional offers for Year 11 pathways

Students applying for entry via Year 11 pathways may receive early conditional offers from the universities.

Conditional offers are not part of SATAC's <u>published offer round schedule</u>. The institutions send the offers, not SATAC.

SATAC will confirm offers for successful applicants from 21 December.

Flinders University and the University of Adelaide are offering Year 11 admission pathways for 2022 entry.

Information about the pathways is available from the institutions.
